



Home – Academy Agreement

Castle Hall Academy will ensure that:

- we strive to achieve academic excellence for our students, develop character and raise aspirations for all
- we provide parents/carers with regular reports and opportunity for discussion about their child's progress
- we set regular home learning
- we contact home if there are concerns about students' behaviour, attitude or attendance
- we contact home on the same day if students are to be detained for more than 10 minutes after the end of the Academy day

Parents/Carers will ensure that:

- your child attends every day, on time
- your child does not take extended family trips or holidays during term-time
- your child has the correct learning equipment needed for the day, including PE kit when necessary
- you support the Academy's policies and regulations on behaviour and uniform including same day after-school detentions after communication from the Academy
- you provide a suitable environment for your child to work at home
- your child completes their home learning on time and to the highest standard
- you attend parent/carer evenings to discuss your child's progress, and any other meetings arranged with your support
- your two contact details are up-to-date and you let reception know if your contact details change – this includes mobile phone numbers and email address
- you support your child in participating in at least one extra-curricular activity
- you pay for the replacement of any equipment or books your child loses or damages

Students will ensure that they:

- work hard in all lessons, expecting work to be challenging and show resilience when it is
- attend everyday, arrive on time, taking pride in wearing the correct uniform and always being equipped
- follow the Academy's rules at all times (work hard, be kind and follow staff instructions first time)
- behave responsibly both at the Academy and travelling to and from the Academy
- complete all home learning to the highest standard and hand it in on time
- treat all adults and other students with respect
- respect the Academy building and equipment and leave all rooms tidy after using them
- do not undermine the safety of others
- do not have their mobile phone out in the academy grounds
- take letters and messages home and deliver them to their parents/carers
- take an active part in the Academy life including clubs, teams, trips and visits (minimum if one extra-curricular activity)
- demonstrate the 5 Rs (Reasoning, resilience, responsibility, respect and reflection)
